

NAME

CURLOPT_PROXYUSERNAME – username to authenticate with a proxy

SYNOPSIS

```
#include <curl/curl.h>
```

```
CURLcode curl_easy_setopt(CURL *handle, CURLOPT_PROXYUSERNAME,  
                           char *username);
```

DESCRIPTION

Pass a char * as parameter, which should be pointing to the zero terminated user name to use for the transfer.

CURLOPT_PROXYUSERNAME(3) sets the user name to be used in protocol authentication with the proxy.

To specify the proxy password use the *CURLOPT_PROXYPASSWORD(3)*.

RETURN VALUE

Returns CURLE_OK if the option is supported, CURLE_UNKNOWN_OPTION if not, or CURLE_OUT_OF_MEMORY if there was insufficient heap space.
